Turning Point was able to answer Sonya's call, give her and her sons a safe place to stay, and counseling on how to create healthy coping strategies to empower them to build new lives, free from violence.

Sonya's story is real, although her name was changed to keep her safe. It is likely that most of us know someone like Sonya, who is afraid to tell her story, afraid to ask for help, afraid the abuse is somehow her fault, or worse, that she deserves it.

Turning Point has been the only safe haven for those affected by domestic violence in the McHenry County community for 43 years. Our no-cost victims services are offered in both English and Spanish. Our emergency shelter assists survivors and their children escaping immediate danger and offers a private, safe, home-like environment for up to three months.
